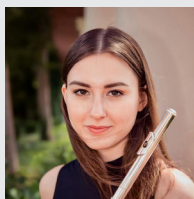
MUSIC EDUCATION

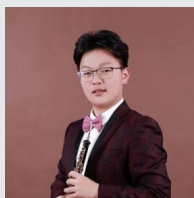
STORIES LEADING THE WAY
